


Entrance Fee / Free

Period / February 2 - March 2, 2025 Business hours / 10:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. (Last reception 2:00 p.m.)

Entrance Fee / 1,200 yen for adults, 600 yen for children (including sledding fee and hot spring bathing fee at Mizunosato. The hot springs open from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., last reception 6:00 p.m.)

You can enjoy sledding and playing in the snow, which is unique to a snowy country. The shop sells hot snacks and drinks.

If you get too cold, you can warm up your body and soul by soaking in the hot springs.
